The embassy in Tokyo, by a Japanese-Canadian architect, is an interesting merger of Canadian architectural ideas with Japanese principals of design.

The Washington embassy is an entirely unique building, both modern and classical—fitting ingeniously into the fabric of D.C.'s classical architectural style.

The Skydome stadium is a building of classical Roman structural ideas, albeit on a massive scale—even by Roman standards of construction—with the modern technological touch of a convertible roof.
